### 4. SPONSORSHIP

A letter or official documentation indicating you are able to pay for the program and living expenses while enrolled in the program.

### 5. DESIGN ABILITY

Illustrate 3 outfits as part of a collection for any season.

- Present designs on 8 1/2" x 11" paper
- Designs must be presented in color
- Front view of designs only

### 6. MARKET RESEARCH

Submit research done on a Canadian Designer or Manufacturer including a brief history, target market, production information, and price points.

### 7. SEWING PROFICIENCY

Students may choose to provide a sample of their sewing ability or complete an MC College sewing class.

**\*All 7 requirements must be provided before a letter of acceptance can be given.**

**\*It is the students responsibility to secure their own accommodation.**

**\*All fees must be paid in full on the first day of the program.**

**\*Each student will be required to provide their own laptop for this program.**
