- Transcripts from post-secondary institutions with official English translations (if applicable)

2. REGISTRATION FEE

3. EVIDENCE OF PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH

4. SPONSORSHIP

A letter or official documentation indicating you are able to pay for the program and living expenses while enrolled in the program.

5. CAREER INVESTIGATION

An essay outlining your knowledge of a career in the beauty industry.

6. CAREER GOALS

A description of why you have chosen Hairstyling or Esthetics as a career and an outline of your future goals.

**All 6 requirements must be provided before a letter of acceptance can be given.*

**It is the students responsibility to secure their own accommodation.*

**All fees must be paid in full on the first day of the program.*

**Each student will be required to provide their own laptop for this program.*
