# MC COLLEGE INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

MC College can ONLY accept International Students who already reside in Canada. If you are an International Student living outside Canada, you are not eligible for acceptance into any MC College programs. MC College can provide assistance in obtaining housing. Students may choose to provide a sample of their sewing ability or complete an MC College sewing class.

\*All 7 requirements must be provided before a letter of acceptance can be given.

\*All fees must be paid in full on the first day of the program.

\*Each student will be required to provide their own laptop for this program.
