

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

MC College can ONLY accept International Students who already reside in Canada. If you are an International Student living outside Canada, you are not eligible for acceptance into any MC College programs. MC College can provide assistance in obtaining housing. Study visas must be obtained through the Government of Canada website:

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REQUIREMENTS AND RESOURCES

1. EDUCATION RECORDS

- High school diploma and transcripts with official English translations
- Transcripts from post-secondary institutions with official English translations (if applicable)

A letter or official documentation indicating you are able to pay for the program and living expenses while enrolled in the program.

4. CAREER INVESTIGATION

An essay outlining your knowledge of a career in the beauty industry.

5. CAREER GOALS

A description of why you have chosen Hairstyling or Esthetics as a career and an outline of your future goals.

6. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT:

The following table outlines language proficiency requirements to attend

Organization	Requirement
IELTS (International English Language Testing System)	Minimum 6.0
TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)	Minimum 80 (internet) Minimum 550 (paper based)
CAEL (Canadian Academic English Language Assessment)	Minimum 60
CELT (Comprehensive English Language Test)	Minimum 60

**Other language proficiency test may be considered.*

*All 6 requirements must be provided before a letter of acceptance can be given.

*It is the student's responsibility to secure their own accommodation.

*All fees must be paid in full on the first day of the program.

*Each student will be required to provide a laptop or tablet for this program.
