HOW TO GET IN

1. EDUCATION RECORDS

High school diploma and transcripts with official English translations Transcripts from post-secondary institutions with official English translations (if applicable)

2. REGISTRATION FEE

3. EVIDENCE OF PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH

4. SPONSORSHIP

A letter or official documentation indicating you are able to pay for the program and living expenses while enrolled in the program.

5. DESIGN ABILITY

Illustrate 3 outfits as part of a collection for any season.

- Present designs on 8 1/2" x 11" paper
- Designs must be presented in color
- Front view of designs only

6. MARKET RESEARCH

Submit research done on a Canadian Designer or Manufacturer including a brief history, target market, production information, and price points.

7. SEWING PROFICIENCY

Students may choose to provide a sample of their sewing ability or complete an MC College sewing class.

8. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

The following table outlines language proficiency requirements to attend.

*All 8 requirements must be provided before a letter of acceptance can be given.
*All fees must be paid in full on the first day of the program.
*Each student will be required to provide their own laptop for this program.

Organization	Requirement
IELTS (International English Language Testing System)	Minimum 6.0
TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)	Minimum 80 (internet) Minimum 550 (paper based)
CAEL (Canadian Academic English Language Assessment)	Minimum 60
CELT (Comprehensive English Language Test)	Minimum 60

**Other language proficiency test may be considered.*

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PROGRAM COSTS & LENGTH

This program is full time for 12 months. We have 1 class per year starting in September.

Tuition: \$16,500.00

Books/Supplies: \$1,254.75 (Includes GST)

Registration Fee: \$200.00

Graduation Fee: \$100.00

MC College is a Private Vocational Institution without degree granting status. Therefore, graduates of our programs are not eligible for the Post Graduate Work Permit. MC College can provide assistance in obtaining housing. Study visas must be obtained through the Government of Canada website:
